the king, O God, the gift of just rule to the crown prince, May he judge your people rightly, be honorable to your meek and lowly" (Psalms 72:1-2; 2 Samuel 8:15) The prophet Micah (750 BC) declared, "God the Creator has shown you, O man, what is good, and what does the Lord require of you but to do justly, to love mercy, and to walk

humbly with your Creator God" (Mic 6:8). Prophets of the Old Testament were champions of Social Justice. During those days, justice was often perverted through bribery and favoritism, or partiality.

It is common knowledge among Sri Lankan citizens that there are several thousand filed court cases yet to be settled which is causing much pain, agony, loss of daily earnings, and cost of travel from distant places. Bro.Noel was moved emotionally to meet so many Pastors and their co-workers waiting for his arrival to obtain needed tracts for the Easter Season. Some of them had to travel from distance places spending a great deal personal money for transportation by buses and and private vehicles.

Reaching every Home in every district, province and share the message of HOPE in Jesus is our aim at any cost. Fresh Expectations

With eager hope, the creation looks forward to the day, when it will join God's children in glorious freedom from death and decay." (Romans 8:20, 21)

All creation is waiting to see the glory of God. When can this happen? How will this happen? How long will it take to happen? Do we know the answers to these?

William Carey said, "Expect great things from God, mpt great things for God."

In 1772 when Carey was ordained as a Baptist minister, he preached this to the Baptist association. His message was his heart's longing, his greatest passion to take the message of Christ to the ends of the earth. His message was based on Isaiah 54:2, 3 which reads "Enlarge your house, build an addition, spread out your home and spare no expenses, for you will be soon bursting at your seams. Your descendants will occupy other nations and resettle the ruined cities. (New Living Translation). It is at this meeting the above mentioned and now famous words came from Carey, "Expect great things from God and attempt great things for God."

All through his life, suffering was Carey's constant companion. But his achievement were innumerable. His achievements surpassed his abilities. He is known as the father of modern missionary movement. His greatest achievement is the translation of Bible into so many languages in India. He knew that without the scriptures in people's heart language, no sustainable nurturing of the Church can happen.

About 110 language groups are still waiting to know God. They do not have even one verse of God's word in their heart language. Let us expect great things from God and let us attempt great things for God!

Not just people, the whole creation is longing for the day of the glory of God upon the earth, in remote language groups and among communities who have not understood God's plan for salvation. They eagerly wait for freedom from death and decay, for hope and peace, from despair and strife.

You are Needed for Serving Together

My wife and I live in a coastal city. During my morning walks, on the beach, I have often noticed fishermen pulling their nets in from the sea. It is a very interesting scene to watch. Over 25 men are on the shore holding the long rope and pulling it slowly into the shore.

Many times, I had lost patience watching them and have walked away though I would have really liked to see their catch. What amazes me of their work is that, such a large group of people need to cooperate and work together for some hours, to bring the catch safely to the shore. In getting the job done, the role of each person holding the net, is equally important. No one can claim

You may think, "are you saying that one person alone can't catch fish?" Sure! But his catch will be too small compared to what a team of people can catch together!

As I thought about the fishermen, I realised, the work of Bible translation is also similar. We need a team of people to complete translation in a language group. We need men and women up in the front, to go and live among the people group. We need people from the community, who will get actively involved in the work. We need people to stand behind them- prayer partners, financial supporters, linguistic consultants, translation consultants, computer experts, and the help of many others.

The role of each one is very important and God blesses this work of unity in a wonderful way. The living Word of God, in the language of the people, is made available, for discipleship and growth of the church among the people.

From sowing to reaping, we need people taking up various roles. In the end there is a big harvest! All of us are important. All have us have to do our role well, with out interruption.

No one, in all of God's household, can do your role, so well as YOU! You are unique, you are designed for Kingdom purposes. Let us serve together to bring God's Kingdom among peoples and nations!

5-fold ministry

Perhaps it would help if it is clarified what it means. "First of all, in case you don't know what I'm talking about, the Five Fold Ministry is a concept taken from one single passage in the New Testament (Ephesians 4:11-13) which says:

"It was he who gave some to be apostles, some to be prophets, some to be evangelists and some to be pastors and teachers." NIV

Why this refutation of the 5-fold ministry:

First, the rejection of the Five Fold concept. It's because Paul himself gives us other two lists elsewhere in his epistles and those other lists are slightly longer, and in a different order, than the one he gives here in Ephesians.

Here follows a very good argument:

Before we look at those other two, let's go ahead and say that this fact alone should tell us that Paul didn't intend for his list in Ephesians to be taken as the only model for church dynamics. If he gave other church members in other cities a different list, then that means he wasn't trying to be dogmatic about this, and that he was speaking loosely about the various gifts that God releases into the Body of Christ for growth, strength, and life. The 8 Fold Ministry

Now let's look at those other two lists, starting with the one in 1 Corinthians 12, verse 28 where Paul says: *"And in the church God has appointed first of all apostles, second prophets, third teachers, then workers of miracles, also those who have gifts of healing, those able to help other, those with gifts of administration and those speaking in different kinds of"* (NIV) *"languages."*

We might conclude from this list that Pastors and Evangelists are lower-class citizens in the church since they're not mentioned at all. We could also easily make a case that Paul's list is hierarchical since he enumerates these by saying, "First of all... second....third..." and so on.

The 7 Fold Ministry

But wait, we're not done. Let's look now at Paul's essential list of gifts in Romans 12. It goes like this: *"For just as each of us has one body with many members, and these members do not all have the same function, so in Christ we, though many, form one body, and each*

member belongs to all the others. We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully."

But, again, the Christians in Rome could easily have taken this list and deduced from it that Apostles, Evangelists, and Pastors are unnecessary in the Church, and that what really counts is Prophecy, Service, Teaching, Encouragement, Giving, Leadership, and Mercy.

Conclusion:

Refutation 1 Yes, today there are apostles (missionaries) there are prophets (speakers of the word of God – even reading the Word of God out loud would qualify). The apostles and prophets in Ephesus 4 are one group in accordance with the context of 2:20 and 3:5. The same goes for pastors and teachers; they are one group, meaning the same people again according to the exegetical rule of "noun kai noun" a noun followed by the word "and" (kai in Greek) again followed by a noun, equals the same people.

Refutation 2 There is not just a 5-fold, but a 15-fold ministry (maybe even a 28-fold ministry). The problem is that Paul is writing to different churches and giving them different lists. So what was valid in Ephesus is not valid in Corinth or Rome and vice versa.

Refutation 3 Following the flow of thoughts of the followers of the 5-fold ministry, the ministries are different according to the city you are in.

Refutation 4 The idea is totally wrong since we are talking about spiritual gifts (charismata in Greek) and not about leadership or the organization of the church, but rather about the organization of the individual believer's spiritual life.

Refutation 5 This adds to the confusion for there is a real 5-fold ministry for the apostolic age mentioned in the Gospels: Matthew 10:7,8.
