They go to forest area and try to hunt rabbit, wild pigs, wild cats, and some birds, and try to make their living for the sake of survival. Since I am being given an opportunity to serve in the Head Quarters of Evangelical Church of India (ECI), I was blessed to meet these people and share God’s love in action.
