M.I. Seoul (30 years): 1992-2022

1. On October 4, 1992, Mission International (M.I.) Seoul Missionary Training Center was established by Rev. Dr. Paulah Kapfo.
2. Many missionaries were sent to different countries: Tanzania, Myanmar, Vietnam, Thailand, Malaysia, India, and China.
3. T.I. (Tent making International) Ministry and M.I. began to work together. Through outreach mission, we preached the word of God and conducted seminars and healing services. America, Japan, England, Philippines, Thailand, Russia, Iran, Malaysia, Indonesia, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan, Myanmar, Singapore, Nepal, Bhutan, and India (16 countries).
4. On January 13, 1997, Mission International Church was planted in Banghakdong, Seoul, Korea.
5. On October 4, 1997, Rev. Dr. Kenny and Rev. Dr. Paulah got married in M.I. Church and started ministry together.
6. In 2003, the first Korean Short Term Mission Team came to Nagaland, then followed by another 10 time mission trips.
7. Since 2005, M.I. Seoul has been holding Mission Support Prayer Meeting for India (Nagaland), every Friday at 04:00 pm
8. On December 20, 2007, Rev. Dr. Paulah Kapfo was sent from M.I. Seoul as a missionary to India.
9. Rev. Dr. Paulah published a book: "God works through our Encounter— India: Nagaland Mission Stories"(2013).






