1. MIGSM (M.I. Graduate School of Missions)



Due to Covid-19 Pandemic situation, our school had long summer vacation, more than two months since May 14 because of total lockdown. But, by the grace of God, this lockdown was somehow relaxed from July 16th onwards and most of the students who went back home returned to campus and MIGSM resumed regular offline classes from July 26th. According to the lecturers' convenience, they offered zoom-meeting classes or on-line WhatsApp classes. They sent study materials and exam-guidelines to the students. Now lecturers and students met together face to face and studied, so and our joy was overflowed and the school was filled with vitality.

For one week, students prepared the final exam with the help of lecturers and had final exam during the first week of August. Those who have finished all their theological courses went back home and will serve in their own local churches, but some students who will pursue higher studies remained in M.I. and started to work as interns for practical ministry for 6 months or 1 year. On August 9th, 2021, MIGSM had chapel service and orientation. From 10th to 12th, all students and staff participated in Bible readings and Spiritual revival meetings.

Outside campus, many families couldn't join worship for some time, so Spiritual hunger grew and as soon as we reopened worship, saints began to join Nagamese morning devotion (Everyday 5 A.M.) women fellowship (Wed.10-11A.M.) and prayer time (4-5P.M.) because of many members and language problems we had divided Nagamese Worship Sunday (9-10:30 A.M) and English worship (11-12:30P.M.).

Some Hindus came to Church through home visitation and prayer. Two of them joined M.I. 3rd& 4th floors construction works. Gods has called His chosen ones and how wonderful they profess their faith. From M.I. Church, we sponsor some M.I. Sent-or Co-operating Missionaries from Manipur, Arunachal Pradesh, Mal Bazar, Kolkata, Nigeria, Philippines, Tripura, Siliguri, Odisha, BirPara, and Tekrube M.I. Prayer House.

3. M.I. Center 3rd -4th Constructions

Since 2018, we have been working for the constructions as we pursue to equip ourselves as a Spiritual Sanctuary. Because of shortage finance, for sometime construction works were stopped and we waited patiently for God's provision by prayer. Miraculously God opened new doors to continue building MIGSM, M.I. Mission Center and Conference Hall.

4. M.I. Prayer House

From green house, through the helped of Bro. Caleb, we built the chapel hall, 6 rooms & two kitchens. These days we have every week regular Sunday Worship (10A.M.), children English classes and prayer.

After lockdown, we have resumed constructions and finished plastering, now we are putting white putty. Five workers are sincerely working and every Friday, from 8-10 am, all our students and staff work together for the constructions. They carry cement, sand and bricks from ground floor to the 3rd and 4th floors. How beautiful it is for all the church members, staff and students to work in unity as a team. 6. M.I. Vocational Centre

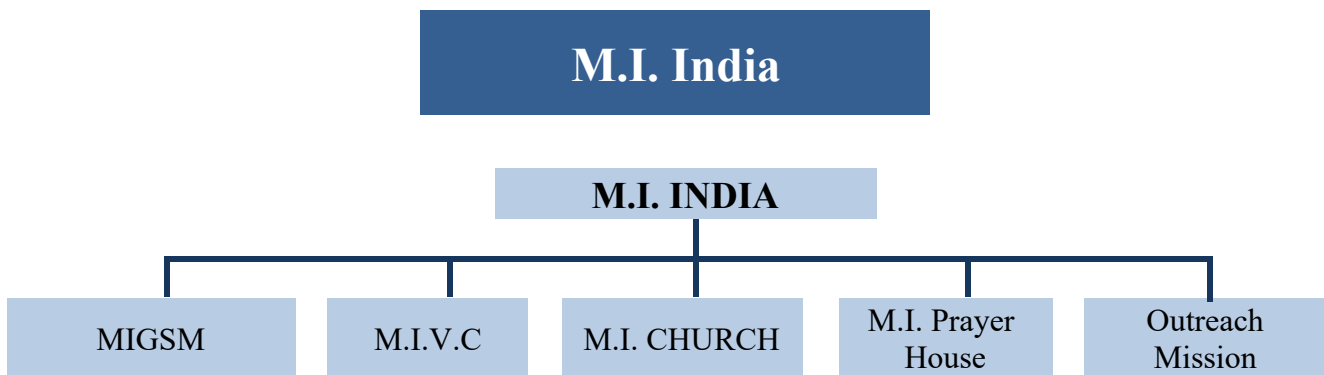


Because of heavy schedules of Academic session, we cannot afford to give all vocational trainings.
